Pre-amble

A structured Volunteer Recognition Program is an important element for any non-profit organization. Volunteer participation is essential to the Canadian Hemophilia Society, Manitoba Chapter's ability to further its mission of helping those with bleeding disorders. Appropriate recognition demonstrates to volunteers that they are valued and it also allows the Chapter to celebrate their significant contributions.

Process

A call for nominations from the membership is made prior to the Annual General Meeting. Submitted, written nominations are then forwarded to the Executive Committee for selection.

STUART JOHNSON AWARD

Awarded to: a Chapter member with a bleeding disorder who has demonstrated devoted services to the causes of the Chapter

Recognition: Plaque to recipient and recipient's name engraved on plaque that remains in office

Given: at the Annual General Meeting Evening Banquet

VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR AWARD

Awarded to: a Chapter member in recognition of outstanding service to the Chapter over the previous year

Recognition: Plaque to recipient and recipient's name engraved on plaque that remains in office

Given: at the Annual General Meeting

YOUTH RECOGNITION AWARD

Awarded to: a member of the Chapter Youth who has shown outstanding leadership and mentoring of the youth

Recognition: Plaque to recipient and recipient's name engraved on plaque that remains in office

Given: at the Annual General Meeting

DIRECTOR'S YEARS OF SERVICE AWARD

Awarded to: Directors who have served either 10, 15, 20 or more years on the Board

Recognition: Special gift and plaque to recipient and recipient's name engraved on plaque that remains in office

Given: at the Annual General Meeting

CORPORATE RECOGNITION AWARD

Awarded to: Corporations - in recognition and appreciation of outstanding corporate support of the bleeding disorders community

Recognition: Plaque to recipient and recipient's name engraved on plaque that remains in office. Notice in Chapter newsletters

Given: at the Annual General Meeting

SPECIAL RECOGNITION AWARD

Awarded to: either a Chapter member or a member of the Bleeding Disorders Care Team who has made a significant contribution to the Chapter within the past year or over a number of years

Recognition: Plaque to recipient and recipient's name engraved on plaque that remains in office.

Given: at the Annual General Meeting Banquet
