



### Pre-amble

A structured Volunteer Recognition Program is an important element for any non-profit organization. Volunteer participation is essential to the Canadian Hemophilia Society, Manitoba Chapter's ability to further its mission of helping those with bleeding disorders. Appropriate recognition demonstrates to volunteers that they are valued and it also allows the Chapter to celebrate their significant contributions.

### Process

A call for nominations from the membership is made prior to the Annual General Meeting. Submitted, written nominations are then forwarded to the Executive Committee for selection.

#### Stuart Johnson Award

**Awarded to:** a Chapter member with a bleeding disorder who has demonstrated devoted services to the causes of the Chapter

**Recognition:** Plaque to recipient and recipient's name engraved on plaque that remains in office

**Given:** at the Annual General Meeting Evening

#### Volunteer of the Year Award

**Awarded to:** a Chapter member in recognition of outstanding service to the Chapter over the previous year

**Recognition:** Plaque to recipient and recipient's name engraved on plaque that remains in office

**Given:** at the Annual General Meeting

#### Youth Recognition Award

**Awarded to:** a member of the Chapter Youth who has shown outstanding leadership and mentoring of the youth

**Recognition:** Plaque to recipient and recipient's name engraved on plaque that remains in office

**Given:** at the Annual General Meeting

#### Director's Years of Service Award

**Awarded to:** Directors who have served either 10, 15, 20 or more years on the Board

**Recognition:** Special gift and plaque to recipient and recipient's name engraved on plaque that remains in office

**Given:** at the Annual General Meeting

### Volunteer Recognition Program

**Awarded to:** Corporations – in recognition and appreciation of outstanding corporate support of the bleeding disorders community

**Recognition:** Plaque to recipient and recipient's name engraved on plaque that remains in office.

**Given:** at the Annual General Meeting

### Special Recognition Award

**Awarded to:** either a Chapter member or a member of the Bleeding Disorders Care Team who has made a significant contribution to the Chapter within the past year or over a number of years

**Recognition:** Plaque to recipient and recipient's name engraved on plaque that remains in office.

**Given:** at the Annual General Meeting

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### Additional Awards

**Awarded to:** A certificate of Appreciation/Recognition may be presented to an individual inside the organization or individuals or groups outside the organization who have made a special contribution to the organization.

The recipient will have made a special contribution in one of the following categories:

- a. A special event
- b. Fundraising campaign
- c. A completed project
- d. Chapter management/operation
- e. Volunteer development
- f. Program delivery

**Recognition:** Unframed certificate

**Given:** at the Annual Volunteer Appreciation Event

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
