Organizational Impact:

Position Summary:

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Research fundraising programs and strategies of selected health related charities
- Research fundraising programs and strategies of selected community based service organizations
- Research third party events, donor strategies and fund development including planned giving, grant opportunities, business opportunities and corporate relationships.
- Will make recommendations that fall within the administrative capacity of the Chapter
- Will learn and respect the Chapter`s mission, values and organizational norms
- Will seek input from content experts as required
- Will submit in advance, expenses, for approval
- Will develop a recommendation for an overall fundraising strategy to support the activities of the Chapter and promote public awareness of those living with inherited bleeding disorders.
